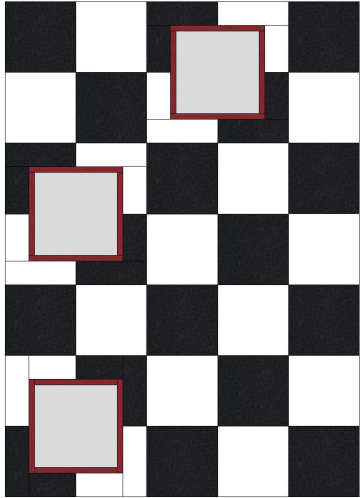


Twilight Mystery Quilt

Step 6: Section 5



1/4" seam allowance

Arrows designate the recommended pressing direction for seams.

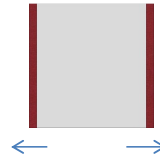
Blocks and fabric cuts needed:

x3 7.5" (with seam allowance) Feature blocks

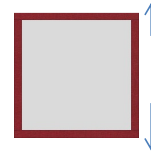
<u>Red#2</u>	<u>White</u>	<u>Black</u>
x 6 1" x 7.5" strips	x11 6.5" squares	x12 6.5" squares
x 6 1" x 8.5" strips	x6 2.5" x 6.5" rectangles	x6 2.5" x 6.5" rectangles
	x6 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles	x6 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles

Using x3 feature blocks and Red#2 strips, assemble these units and set aside:

a) attach 1" x 7.5" strips to left and right sides of all Feature blocks

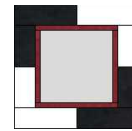


b) attach 1" x 8.5" strips to top bottom of all Feature blocks



*block should measure 8.5" x 8.5"

Make x3 blocks:



*blocks should measure 12.5" x 12.5"

Using x6 each 2.5" x 4.5" white and black rectangles, assemble these block parts.



*unit should measure 2.5" x 8.5", make x6 (press x2 to white and x4 to black)

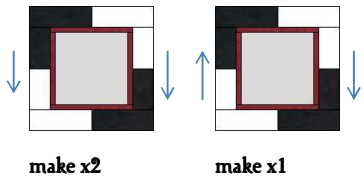
Using x6 each 2.5" x 6.5" white and black rectangles, assemble these block parts.



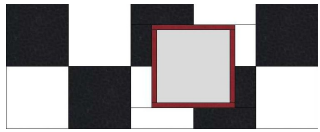
*unit should measure 2.5" x 12.5", make x6

*sew 2.5" x 8.5" black and white units to the left and right of each Feature block (see diagram below for suggested unit placement for the purpose of recommended seam direction)

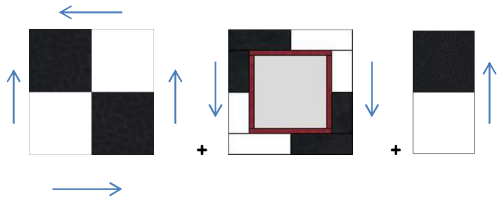
*sew 2.5" x 12.5" black and white units to the top and bottom of each Feature block



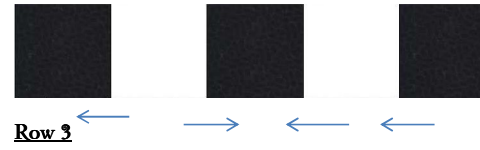
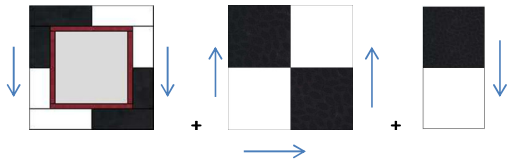
Assemble Section 5:



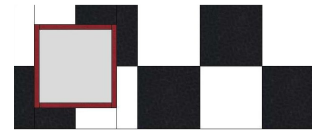
Row 1



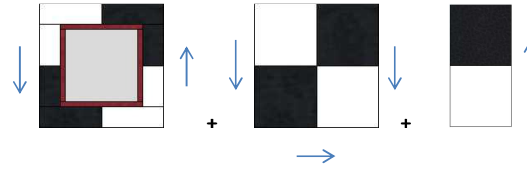
Row 2
